

Energy - Customer Service Business Policy Statement for the Management of Health, Safety & Environment



HS&E

General Policy

This is the health, safety and environment policy of Rolls-Royce Energy Customer Service Business (CSB). It is implemented by a documented health, safety and environment management system. The system:

- Defines the controls for health, safety and environment to enable CSB to comply, as a minimum, with relevant statutory requirements, Group Policy and other requirements agreed with customers. Any customer requirements are contained within HSE Plans/ Interface documents.
- Provides for the achievement of continual improvement through the setting and review of objectives and targets.
- Facilitates the prevention and reduction of injury and ill health, damage to property and the prevention of any pollution as a result of CSB activities.

Risk Assessment

The assessment of foreseeable risks and the establishment of appropriate risk control measures are fundamental to controlling workplace hazards and meeting environmental responsibilities. Risk assessments will:

- Be applied to all activities to ensure appropriate provision is made to address environmental impacts and health and safety considerations, with the aim of eliminating the risk, substituting safer materials and preventing pollution.

Communication

Management are committed to the effective communication of information on health, safety and environment matters. Such communication is effected through:

- HSE committees.
- HSE representatives and champions.
- Team briefings.
- The management structure.

Responsibilities

The Director CSB accepts overall responsibility for the implementation and development of this policy, the provision of adequate resources and is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of employees and reducing health, safety and environmental impacts.

Management are responsible for:

- The active support of this policy.
- The health and safety of all people in their area including visitors and contractors.
- Ensuring compliance with HSE procedures.
- Ensuring all incidents and near-misses are reported and investigated.

All employees and contractors will:

- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety and ensure their activities do not affect that of others.
- Use all safety equipment provided.
- Comply with all safety rules, instructions and emergency procedures.
- Report all HS&E incidents, near-misses, unsafe acts and conditions to supervision immediately.
- Take care to prevent environmental incidents.
